## Are you open during the day throughout the week?

Right now, we are open on weekday evenings only. As times and dates may change, keep an eye on the Museum website.

## How long is the trail?

The skate trail is approximately 1 kilometre in length.

## When will the tickets go on sale?

Tickets go on sale the same day, generally by 11 a.m. on weekdays and 8:30 a.m. on weekends. Staff need to verify the condition of the trail and weather before opening.

## Can I buy tickets in advance?

Tickets are only available same day. Staff access the trail conditions daily and make sure it's safe before opening. Check the website/ social media before visiting the skate trail.

## Do members get in for free?

Members receive a discounted rate; \$8 for adults, \$6 for children and youth (ages 4-24), and children under 4 are free.

## I don't skate, can I walk along with my group?

Unfortunately, only skaters are allowed on the trail. You are welcome to wait at the Sugar Shack while your group skates.

## Can I bring my dog?

Unless they can skate, dogs are not allowed on the skate trail.

## Do you rent skates?

At this time, we do not have skates available for rent.

## If the Museum is open, does that mean the trail is too?

Trail hours are listed above and do not coincide with the Museum hours. The Museum is open 7 days a week from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
