CALL FOR ENTRY – SIMCOE COUNTY RESIDENTS QUILTS AND QUILT RELATED ITEMS

RULES FOR ENTRY:

1. Simcoe County residents (who do not belong to a Guild) may enter a quilt or quilt related item into the show. Complete the Quilted Items Intent Form for Simcoe County Residents.
2. 2024 Featured Theme is “Sew What!”. Themed entries must be a wall hanging and is limited to a maximum perimeter of 120 inches (e.g. 20” x 40”).
3. A maximum of 3 quilts / quilt related items may be entered in the Show (e.g. quilt, wall hanging and / or featured theme wall hanging). Antique quilts are welcome.
4. Your quilt or quilt related item may not have been previously shown at the Simcoe County Museum.
5. Quilted Items Intent Forms must be submitted by July 31 at the latest. Late Forms will not be accepted.
6. All items must be delivered to the Museum’s receiving area on Tuesday, September 17, 2024 starting at 10 am. Quilts and quilt related items are accepted until 1 pm. Late items will not be accepted.
7. The Show Committee reserves the right not to hang an entry. Any item not accepted will be returned with a reason for not being hung.
8. All entries to be hung (e.g. quilts, wall hangings) must have a sleeve sewn-in or attached to the back with safety pins (no straight pins).
 - Full sized quilts and large wall hangings: minimum of a 4” sleeve.
 - Minis and smaller wall hangings: an appropriate sized sleeve.Entries without sleeves will not be hung.
9. All wall hangings and minis must have a solid rod that will support their weight (e.g. thick wooden dowel), is 4” longer than the item and has your name on it or it will not be hung.
10. All submitted items must have a label with your name on it attached to the back. This is for your protection.
11. If your item is for sale, it will be tagged: ‘For Sale – \$ Price’ and will display the size. Changes to the price are not accepted after the form is submitted. Ensure the size is accurate. A 15% commission is retained by Simcoe County Quilters on the first \$850 on items sold.
12. Pick up time is 4:30 pm (not sooner) Sunday, September 22, 2024 at the Simcoe County Museum.

Note: Quilt or quilt related items must be sewn and fabric based. Kits and grab bags are not acceptable.
