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RULES FOR ENTRY:

1. Simcoe County residents (who do not belong to a Guild) may enter finished quilts / wall hangings / featured theme, referred to as quilted items, into the show.
2. Wall hanging entries are limited to a maximum perimeter of 250 inches (e.g. 50" x 75").
3. 2026 Featured Theme is "Black & White With A Splash Of One Colour". Use black and white fabric and add ONE more colour to create a wall hanging. Themed entries must be a wall hanging and is limited to a maximum perimeter of 120 inches (e.g. 20" x 40").
4. A maximum of 3 quilted items may be entered in the Show (e.g. 2 quilts + 1 wall hanging; or 1 quilt + 1 wall hanging + 1 themed wall hanging). Antique quilts are welcome.
5. Your quilt or quilt related item may not have been previously shown at the Simcoe County Museum.
6. Quilted Items Intent Forms must be submitted by July 31 at the latest. Late Forms will not be accepted.
7. All quilted items must be delivered to the Museum's receiving area on Monday, September 14, 2026 starting at 10 am and are accepted until 1 pm. Late items will not be accepted.
8. The Show Committee reserves the right not to hang an entry. Any item not accepted will be returned with a reason for not being hung.
9. **All entries to be hung (e.g. quilts, wall hangings) must have a sleeve sewn-in or attached to the back with safety pins (no straight pins).**
10. **Full sized quilts and large wall hangings: minimum of a 4" sleeve.**
11. **Minis and smaller wall hangings: an appropriate sized sleeve.**
12. No corner sleeves.
13. Entries without sleeves will not be hung.
14. All wall hangings and minis must have a solid rod that will support their weight (e.g. thick wooden dowel), is 4" longer than the item and has your name on it or it will not be hung.
15. All submitted items must have a label with your name on it attached to the back. This is for your protection.
16. If your item is for sale, it will be tagged: 'For Sale – \$ Price' and will display the size. Changes to the price are not accepted after the form is submitted. Ensure the size is accurate. A 15% commission on items sold is retained by Simcoe County Quilters.
17. Pick up time is 4:30 pm (not sooner) Sunday, September 20, 2026 at the Simcoe County Museum.

Note: Quilted items must be sewn and fabric based.
